Men's Health Friday: The Vasectomy

- 1. A vasectomy is a **quick procedure** that is normally performed whilst awake.
- 2. You're **not immediately sterile**. Viable sperm can live for several weeks in your system. Other contraception, like condoms, need to be used for 8-12 weeks until the vasectomy is confirmed by 1-2 sperm count tests.
- 3. You'll still have erections and ejaculate, but your semen won't contain sperm.
- 4. A vasectomy in >99% effective as a method of contraception
- 5. You must consider a vasectomy to be permanent. Whilst reversal procedures are possible privately, the success rate is 50% or less.
- 6. Your sex drive is **not** affected by the procedure.
- 7. A vasectomy does not protect against STIs
- 8. It is a **safe and non-hormonal method** of contraception if your family is complete
- 9. Your GP can talk you through the referral process. From Wingerworth, most referrals go to Wheatbridge Health Village, the local sexual health clinic which conducts vasectomies.
